ANNE'S PURSE tracked the leaders while inside, angled out in early stretch, bid and rallied strong to go clear of the others. KOONUNGA HILL four wide in the early going, backed off to stalk the leaders on the turn, bid outside in the run to the wire and proved second best. BOLD MANEUVER trailed a tight field then angled out turning for home, bid in the four path and finished well. EDAMAME duelled between foes and was head and head into the stretch, led briefly then evened out. BENT ATTORNEY duelled three wide and was a factor turning for home then faltered. ONLY IF SPLIT had inside speed, held very slim lead into the turn, battled from the rail into the stretch then gave way inside.
