Following the 3rd race we received a call from Test Barn personnel, the #2 horse Dixie Brew, participated in the 2<sup>nd</sup> race, placed second and subsequently sent for post-race testing, had reared up when the test inspector attempted to obtain an EIPH blood sample and the needle either broke or fell off the hub and was not located. They were able to obtain a partial sample. Dr. Nugent attended the test barn, the horse was examined for any indication of the needle remaining in the vein and a magnet was used to locate it in the test stall. A report was filed.
