given the opportunity of knowing the first offence in the 3rd race, the Stewards took this into consideration and issued a first offence violation of \$200.00. Notified Mr. Mailhot.

Doors were secured and Omi's boy received a fair start. #8 Now We Are Nine stumbled at start, #1 Gold Sting off a step slow, #5 Waubaushene checked after the start as #6, Midnite Snackattak bore in, rest ok. Spoke with D. Johnson #6, asked that he give a little more room to the inside horses when moving laterally left.

Race 6, #5 Princess Moro stumbled at start, Spoke with #6 Jockey Sunny Singh, 1st, he appeared to open his left hand and look over at the Jockey on #2, K. Johnson, 2nd as they were crossing the finish line. Asked him to refrain from this motion as perception is not favorable to the wagering public.
