**ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Maintains a clean and safe work environment. Perform duties in compliance with safety procedures, which include use of safety equipment. Incumbents are responsible for following safety procedures, identifying unsafe practices or conditions and informing their supervisor or the Safety Committee of unsafe conditions, as directed.
2. Responsible for filing, cleaning and distribution of all racing silks as they enter and exit the jockey's room.
3. Ensures each jockey is given and is wearing the correct set of silks for each race.
4. Performs other duties, including special projects, as needed and directed by the clerk of scales and Horsemen's Liasson

Must be able to obtain all required licenses from applicable regulatory agencies, including the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).
